At the November 12th VetBuds meeting at Gustons Grille in Woodstock, Sgt. Jordan "Jay" Millirons, USA, 2007-L2014, brought his "Fighter Plane wrapped Mustang" Old Glory.

Below is the story behind this unique project.

I was a car enthusiast before entering the military. In 2022 I bought a stock 21 Mustang GT premium and added performance and visual enhancements.

While participating at car shows and other events, I Noticed the lack of veteran support and decided to change that situation. Hence, "Project Old Glory", a show vehicle that promotes veteran charities and their associated logos.

You'll notice that "Project Old Glory" "Wrap" has a military theme. The purpose is to create something familiar to veterans and appealing to others. I partnered with several PTSD support groups to help raise awareness for their missions. They are as follows: VetBuds, Mission 22, Purple Heart Foundation, Stop Soldier Suicide, K9's for Warriors, Paws for Life K9 Rescue, The Taylor Foundation, Wounded Warrior Project, Tunnels to Towers and Cherokee Homeless Vets. Some of the expense for "Project Old Glory" was offset through the generosity of others. Their participation helped to launch the mission of "Project Old Glory" and present it to the world.
